Member Advantages

- Ghin handicap is included in membership
- Discounted rental cart
- Reduced pricing on range balls
- Use of the practice green facility is unlimited
- No additional green fee charged
- Guests playing with a member receive discount on green fee
- Member only golf tournaments throughout the season
- Opportunity to play in Berkshire County Allied Events
- Reduced Entry Fees for Charity Events hosted by Waubeeka

Membership

- All members shall be paid in full before the season starts. Members who took advantage of the budget plans are able to play during their payment plan period, if you are in arrears your playing privileges are suspended until your account is brought back into good standing.
- There are no refunds of season dues once season begins.

Tee Time Reservations

- **Twosomes not allowed on weekend mornings before 11am, must be paired with another twosome or single**
- 10 days in advance, non members 7 days
- No Junior/ College member play weekend mornings before 11am unless playing with an adult

Pro Shop

- Hours of Operation are 7am to 7pm. Early spring and late fall hours are 8am to 6pm.
- Winnings from member tournaments will be issued through the pro shop as sweep credits which expire on November 1. Tourney Sweeps must be redeemed for pro shop merchandise.
- Gift Cards can be used for pro shop merchandise, green fees, cart rentals or food & beverage.
- Discounted Range Balls available through our Smart Card System

Clubhouse

- Our clubhouse / Pub & Grill will open 15 minutes before the first tee time and close ½ hour after dark.
- All food and beverage consumed on our property must be purchased from our Pub & Grill
- Minors are not allowed to sit at the bar area
- Pets are prohibited in the clubhouse, pro shop and patio area
- Acceptable standards of conduct and of dress are expected in all areas, at all times
- Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times on the premises

Golf Course Etiquette

We are looking to you, as a member, to keep our awesome course conditions just as you found them after every stroke out of respect for the player behind you.

- Our Superintendent Greg Tudor and his staff do a magnificent job in maintaining the course and green conditions that everyone has come to expect. With yours and everyone's help we can maintain the level of expectations of excellent playing conditions on a daily basis throughout the season. With this in mind we need you to help us while we institute the following policies.

Ball Marks

- Fix and repair properly. We have signage for ball mark repairs and if you have any questions please speak to our pro shop staff and they will be more than willing to show you the correct procedure in the fixing of a ball mark.

Bunkers

- Always rake your tracks after playing out of the bunkers so the players behind you don't find their ball in your footprint or divot.

Divot Repair

- There are divot mix boxes on every par 3 tee. We would expect that you would fill your divots with the mix and also replace your fairway and rough divots as well.

Pull Carts

- Pull carts and "kangaroo" carts are not to traverse greens, tee boxes, bunkers or between bunkers and greens

Pace of Play

- The traditional four hour round is the standard at Waubeeka. Please make every effort to see that your group finishes on time.
- Faster groups should be allowed to play through slower groups
- No groups of five allowed

Gas Cart Policy

- Carts are to exit fairways at our new cart path posts 30 yards from green using cart paths around greens and following directional signage. Driving over newly installed mounding throughout the course is prohibited. Carts should never be closer than 30 yards from a green.
- We are going to address the ongoing issue of players non compliance of gas carts being **too close to the greens, behind greens and players not adhering to the cart rules of the day which include path only and 90* rule.** If you are one who already respects these simple golf cart etiquette rules we Thank You for your respect of our course.
- After being informed of and witnessing players “hitching” a free ride, riding in a cart that was ½ paid for, both riders must now possess their receipt for the rental of the cart. **Any player stopped without a receipt and is riding unpaid will be asked to return to the pro shop, pay the rental fee, and will be not be entitled to any reimbursement of their membership and such player will no longer have playing privileges at Waubeeka.**
- Only two carts per foursome
- Carts are not allowed in the parking lot
- Junior members must possess a valid driving license to rent a cart
- Read and obey the rules of operating carts posted for that day of play

Driving Range & Practice Facility

- The driving range will be open during regular pro shop hours
- The driving range and practice facility is under video surveillance
Practicing on our range with your own balls is prohibited.
Waubeeka RangeBalls and Bags do not leave our range or property.
